Advice about support

Your Parish Council is in contact with local Community Groups to ensure help is available for all residents who require assistance. Including those who are self-isolating or restricting their movements because they are particularly vulnerable due to age, situation or underlying health problems. All households will be affected in some way, and plans are being put in place to:

- Check on any vulnerable families, friends and neighbours. This is for help with medication, food, finance, general welfare problems or just a friendly voice.
- Identify those who are self-isolating to arrange to contact them and check that they're ok.
- Ensure residents are kept informed of the help available.
- Identify volunteers who are willing to assist in providing practical assistance (eg. collecting and delivering shopping to those who are self-isolating).
- Ensuring that everyone in the village gets access to the same and most accurate information.
