COMMUNITY CORNER UPDATE

If you are or know a vulnerable person, make sure they are on the priority register for the North West Electricity. They will be contacted in advance of an imminent power cut so that they can plan ahead. Phone 105 to register.

PARISH COUNCIL'S BUDGET

The Annual Finance meeting was held on 6th February when the 2019/2020 budget was reviewed in order to determine the budget for 2020/2021. Taking into account the Bank of England rate of inflation, it was unanimously agreed that the precept for Foulridge Parish Council should increase by 2.1%. The cost for Band D properties for 2020-2021 will be £37.90 per annum. This equates to an increase of 25p per annum per Band D property ie LESS THAN 1p per week!

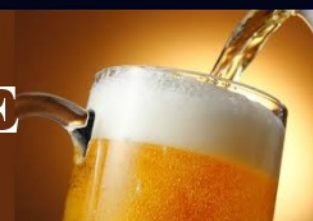
