**HIGH LANE AND SYCAMORE RISE, FOULRIDGE, PENDLE BOROUGH
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2023**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of High Lane and Sycamore Rise, Foulridge. High Lane will be closed from outside number 1 High Lane to its junction with Lowther Lane. Sycamore Rise will be closed from its junction with Rowan Drive to its junction with High Lane.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 24th July 2023 until 1700 hours on Friday 4th August 2023 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
High Lane - Foulridge, Whitemoor Road - Foulridge, High Lane – Salterforth, Higher Lane – Salterforth, Manchester Road – Barnoldswick, Church Street – Barnoldswick, Skipton Road – Barnoldswick, Fernlea Avenue – Barnoldswick, Essex Street – Barnoldswick, Kelbrook Road – Barnoldswick, Kelbrook Road – Salterforth, Kelbrook Road – Kelbrook, Colne Road – Kelbrook, Skipton New Road – Foulridge and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow construction of new manhole works to be carried out.
